

State of Emergency Red River Parish

WHEREAS, the parish of Red River is presently faced with civil emergency;

WHEREAS, Rain, Sleet and Snow has caused serious problem to roads, infrastructures, bridges and businesses in the City of Coushatta, including the Red River Parish Court House and Red River Parish

WHEREAS, the current condition of Red River Parish is Snow, Rain, Freezing and Icing Of roads, homes and businesses with freezing of steps, and doors at the court house

WHEREAS, there is a very definite threat to life and property of the citizens of this parish; and dangerous in the court house because of snow, rain and freezing conditions at the Red River Parish Court House

WHEREAS, such action must be taken now; to protect and secure Infrastructures', roads and citizens of our parish and the closure of the Red River Parish Court House on Tuesday, January 16, 2018, through Wednesday, January 17, 2018, because roads are closed and Icing at the Court house and more to come to night

THEREFORE, I, Shawn Beard, President of the Red River Parish Police Jury by Authority vested in me by the Parish Charter and the Louisiana Disaster Act of 1993, do hereby proclaim;

A STATE OF EMERGENCY to exist within the parish and that all Emergency Preparedness plans and the Parish's All Hazard Emergency Operations Plan is activated.
